



Nwestco COVID-19 Safety Statement

The health and safety of Nwestco employees, customers, and communities remain our top priority. Nwestco has provided guidance and support using appropriate combinations of engineering and administrative controls, safe work practices, and personal protective equipment (PPE) to prevent workplace exposures. This communicated guidance is intended to help prevent workplace exposure to acute respiratory illnesses, including COVID-19.

Nwestco is open! We have been deemed “essential” and we are here to support our customers. Nwestco puts the safety and health of our employee-partners and customers as our highest priority. We follow and encourage proper social distancing and the strongest hygiene and sanitation practices. Field technicians are working safely to fulfill your service needs and administrative staff is working remotely.

Guidance:

- Frequently wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. When soap and running water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand rub with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands that are visibly soiled.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Proper PPE is available and strongly encouraged. This includes protective masks, gloves, eye protection, and sanitizing options.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet must be practiced.
- Employees must stay at home if they are ill.
- Employees must report if they have been in contact with someone who is ill.
